7.1 UPDATED APPLICATION – DVP 22-04; Development Variance Permit; 2710 Lakeridge Road

THAT Council approve the issuance of a Development Variance Permit (DVP 22-04) for 2710 Lakeridge Road to vary the following sections of Zoning Bylaw No. 0154 in accordance with the attached draft permit:

- S.10.4.5(f.3) to increase the height of a carriage house from 1.5 to 2 storeys;
- S.3.26.5 to allow a carriage house roof to be higher than the peak of the principal detached dwelling;
- S.3.26.6 to allow for a carriage house with two storeys to have greater than 75% of the main floor area on the upper storey; and

THAT Council permit the construction of a second storey deck on a carriage house in accordance with Proposal 1 outlined in this report (S.3.26.11).
