Subject:	Amendment to the Freedom of Information and Bylaw 2009 No. 0037 (Adoption)	Protection of Privacy

#### RECOMMENDATION

**THAT** Council consider and resolve to adopt the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Amending Bylaw 2009 No. 0037.01.

#### BACKGROUND

Local bodies have the authority to create a Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Bylaw under s.77 of the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*. This legislation allows for a public body to designate, by bylaw, persons to act as the Head. The current bylaw requires updating to reflect changes that West Kelowna is no longer a District but a municipality, along with updating positions to reflect current titles within the organization. Council gave first, second and third reading to the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Amending Bylaw at the November 22, 2002 Regular Council Meeting.

The Bylaw is now before Council for consideration of adoption.
