Highlights of the Regional Board meeting – November 10, 2022

2022 - 2023 Regional Board

At the Inaugural Statutory meeting of the Regional District Board, the Oath of Office was administered and signed by all directors. Kelowna councillor Loyal Wooldridge was acclaimed by directors to serve a second year as chair. West Kelowna mayor Gord Milsom was acclaimed as vice-chair serving for a fifth year.

The Regional District Board consists of 12 voting members representing the Central Okanagan East and Central Okanagan West electoral areas, and municipal appointees from the City of Kelowna, City of West Kelowna, District of Lake Country and District of Peachland. Westbank First Nation is represented with a non-voting member appointed by Chief and Council.

The number of directors and voting strength of each is based on population and the voting unit is specified in the Letters Patent for the Regional District. The Provincial government approved an increase in the voting unit from 4,000 to 5,500 people. As a result, the City of Kelowna now appoints six of the 12 voting directors.



Regular curbside garbage, recycling and yard waste collection continues Friday, Nov. 11


The Westside Residential Waste Disposal & Recycling Centre, North Westside & Traders Cove transfer stations continue normal operations

No flower pots, bags of any kind, pet waste, kitchen scraps, rocks, soil, sod or garbage



Accepted Items:

- Leaves
- Branches
- Prunings
- Pumpkins
- Needles
- Grass Clippings
- Fruit Droppings

Keep material loose, to allow for proper cart emptying.

Size limitations apply. Remember, you can also take your yard waste year round to the Glenmore Landfill or Westside Residential Recycling and Disposal Center (Fees apply).
