NOTICE OF PROPOSED BYLAW AMENDMENT

In accordance with Section 124(3) of the Community Charter, the City of West Kelowna intends to adopt "CITY OF WEST KELOWNA COUNCIL PROCEDURE AMENDMENT BYLAW NO. 0258.03, 2022" (a bylaw to regulate the meetings of Council).

The purpose of the amendment is to adjust the meeting time on the second Tuesday of each month. The proposed bylaw will adjust the start time from 1:30 p.m. to 3:30 p.m. and change the adjournment time from 5:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m.
