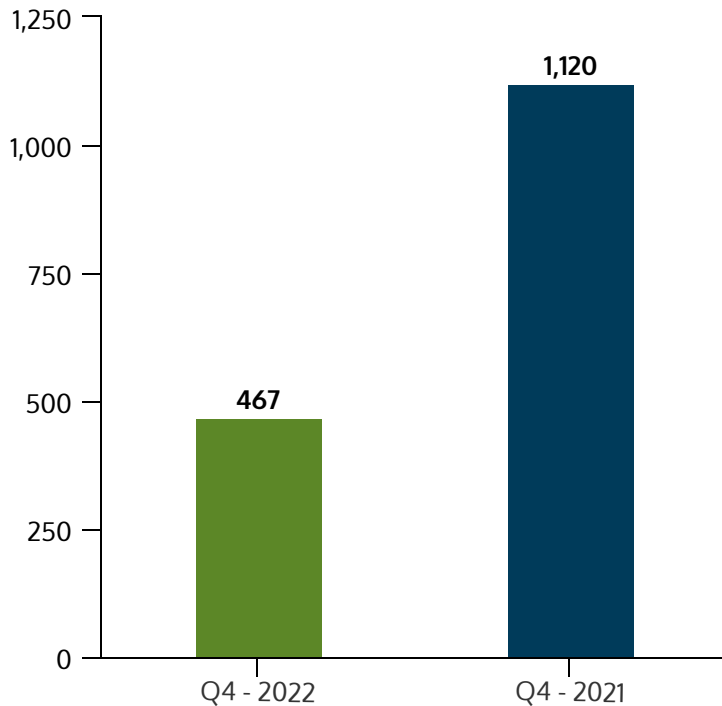
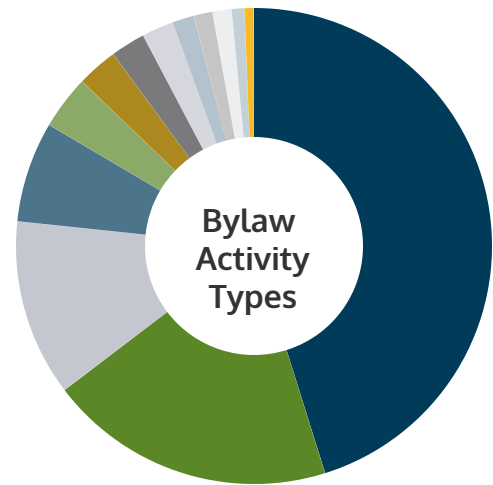


## Bylaw Services

### Bylaw Activities

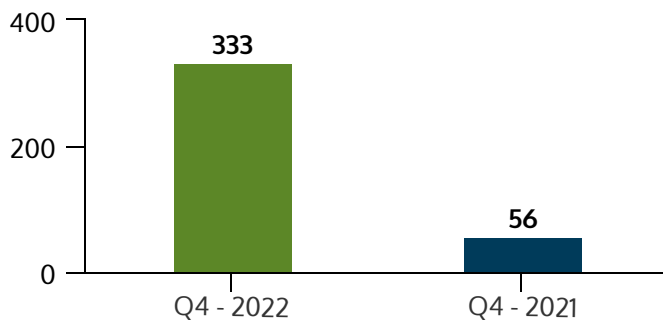


- Q4 2022 activities significantly decreased from Q4 2021 due to a shift in operational priorities. Due to seasonal non-public use, city parks only visited on complaint basis.
- Priority given to active file investigations resulted in a 60% decrease in number of files carried over to 2023, compared to the number of files carried over to 2022.

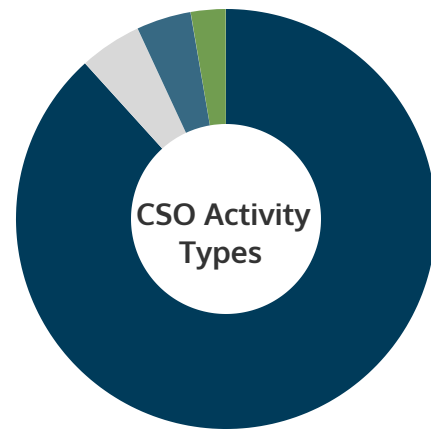

### Community Support Officer (CSO) Activities



- Q4 increase in activities is mainly due to an administrative adjustment to data entry at start of 2022.
- CSO, accompanied by a Bylaw Officer, re-inspected camps on Crown land (Bartley & Brookhaven) approximately 100 times in 2022.
