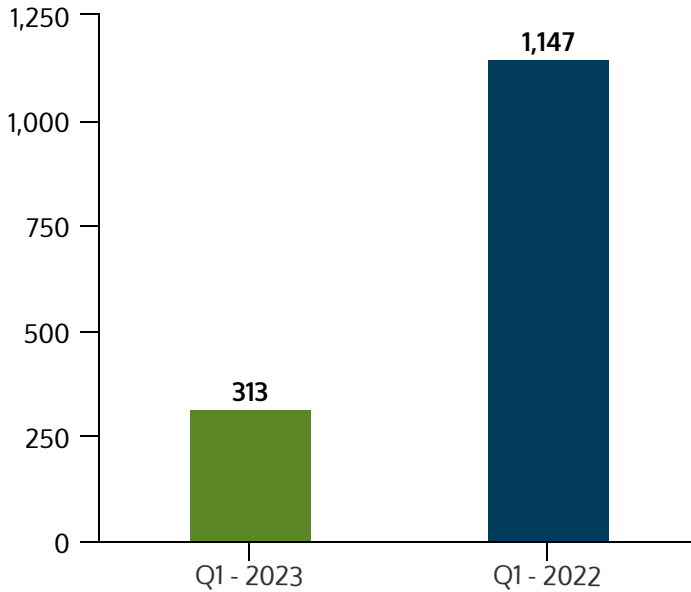


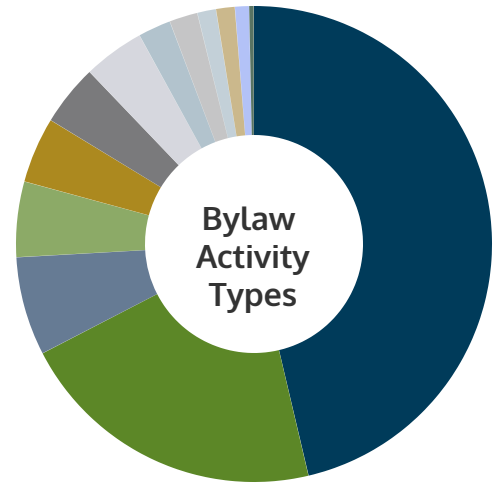

Bylaw Activities

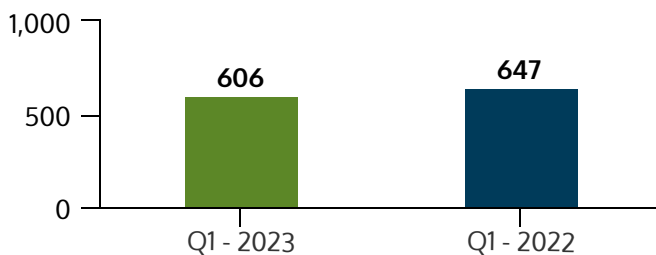


- Q1 2023 activities significantly decreased from Q1 2022 due to a shift in operational priorities. Patrols of known high risk areas patrolled daily, while less used City parks and spaces patrolled on a complaint basis during Q1.
- Bylaw continues to assist other CWK departments with investigations and tow service requests.
- In Q1, Bylaw & RCMP Traffic Officer frequented SD23 schools, and other high traffic zones in a joint effort to deter hazardous parking during peak times.

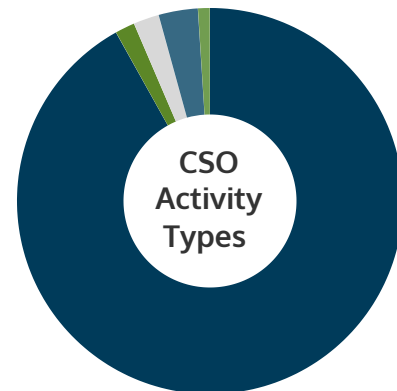
