## Highlights of the Regional Board meeting – March 30, 2023

---

### Tribute to Al Horning

The Regional Board recognized the recent passing of former Kelowna councillor, RDCO Director, MLA and MP Al Horning. Chair Loyal Wooldridge says Al was a friend and colleague who dedicated his career to serving the people of the Central Okanagan. In addition to his political achievements, in 2021 he was inducted into the Central Okanagan Sports Hall of Fame for his lifetime contribution to local sports. The Board extended its deepest condolences to the Horning family.

### Five-year Financial Plan bylaw

The Regional Board has adopted the 2023-2027 Financial Plan bylaw. It totals almost \$61.5-million for operations in 2023, which includes over \$13.2-million in debt with the Municipal Finance Authority on behalf of local governments and the Okanagan Regional Library. The tax impact for the average property owner varies depending on location and services received from the regional district.

### Electoral area Directors 2023 conferences

The Regional Board approved the attendance and expenses of Central Okanagan East Director Kevin Kraft and Central Okanagan West Director Wayne Carson for six local government conferences in 2023 including the Southern Interior Local Government Association, Union of BC Municipalities and Federation of Canadian Municipalities annual meetings.

### Planning Applications

The Regional Board considered the following planning applications:

- **Agricultural Land Commission (ALC) Referral Application #65674 (RDCO file A-22-04)** – The Regional Board supports and will forward an application to the ALC to subdivide the property at 5705 Upper Booth Road into two lots that are bisected by the road.
- Supports discharging a covenant for Lot 4, Lakeshore Road (**RDCO file DP-22-30**, Peter Schrocksnadel, owner) restricting the location of a septic field on the property. With environmental reports and support from Interior Health, the applicant proposes locating the septic field on the property, further from Okanagan Lake.
- Approved **Development Variance Permit application VP-22-10** for 6730 Marbella Loop (Rose Cunningham, owner) to allow an increase in the length of an exterior stairway that is permitted to project into a side yard setback on the property.

## Regional Hospital District budget bylaw

The Central Okanagan Regional Hospital District (CORHD) Board has adopted the 2023-2027 Financial Plan bylaw. The 2023 budget proposes the CORHD provide \$36.7-million for its share in funding new and previously approved capital equipment and projects requested by Interior Health. Among the significant new funding requests for this year: additional costs for Endovascular treatment equipment and additional acute care beds at Kelowna General. In 2023, the average Central Okanagan household will contribute \$19.09 for every \$100,000 of assessed value toward valuable capital and health equipment in the region. That's \$1.98 (9%) less than in 2022.


Our OFFICE WILL RE-OPEN to serve you


