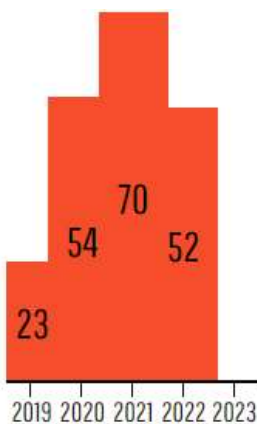

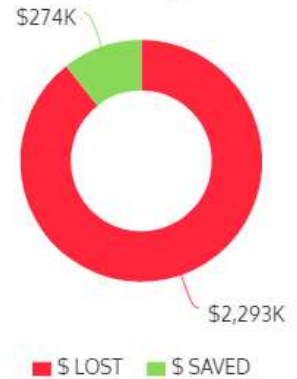

COVID restrictions reduced inspections completed in 2020 and 2021

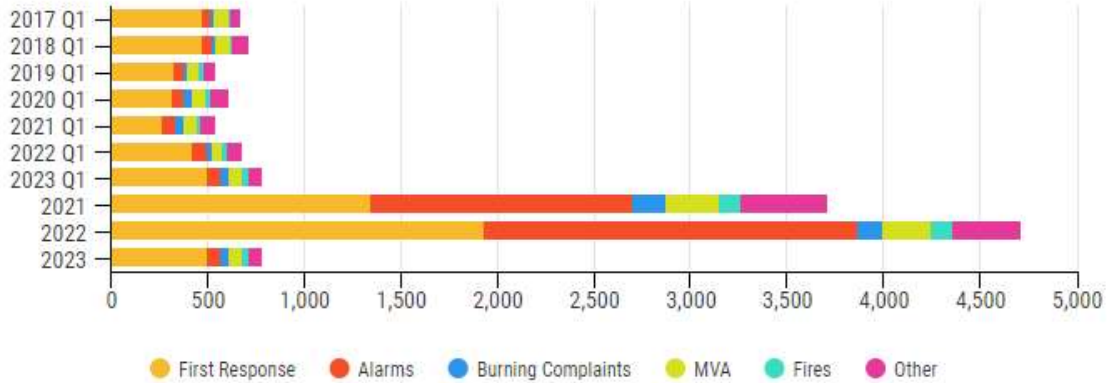

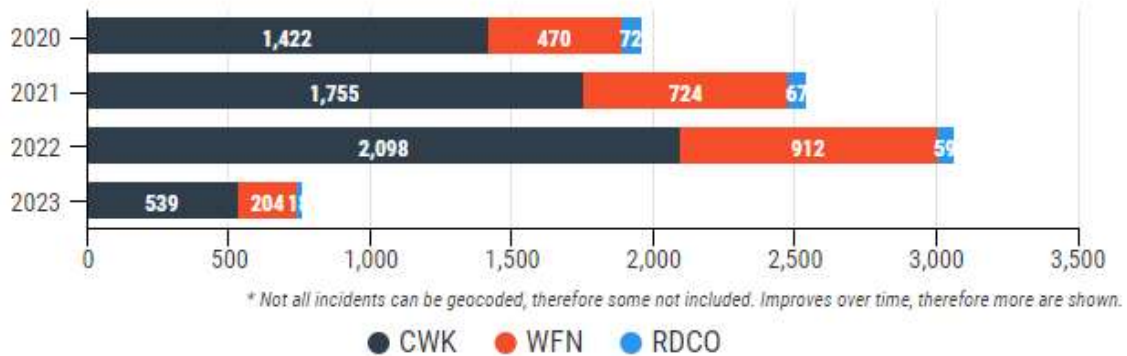
