


## Bylaw Services






- A second seasonal Officer was hired in April, increasing the Bylaw members to five (5) Bylaw Officers, and one (1) Community Support Officer for the summer months.
- 115 Active file investigations
- 208 Bylaw Notices were issued (Warnings, Tickets, MTI)
- Bylaw received 14 complaints from the public for STA properties: Good Neighbour - Noise (8), Absentee Owner, Garbage, and/or Parking (3), License and Operation enquires (3).
- 7 STA files remain active, 7 STA files are now closed: voluntary compliance (3), compliance after fines (3).
- Bylaw received 1 file from B.L. Dept. for enforcement.



## Community Support Officer (CSO) Activities



- Number of unhoused individuals: 39-42
- A seasonal Officer has been designated to assist the CSO.
- The CSO is currently collaborating with Westbank Law Enforcement, and Turning Points on a monthly basis to provide a unified front with respect to community safety, encampments, and identify the best supports for individuals experiencing homelessness.
