BACKGROUND

Councillor Tasha Da Silva and Councillor Carol Zanon attended the Local Government Leadership Academy (LGLA) Elected Officials Seminar held at the Delta Hotel in Kelowna from March 1 to March 3, 2023. The LGLA supports and promotes education and training for local governments and First Nations elected officials and senior administrators throughout the province. This program offered stimulating and interesting segments for both newly elected councillors and those re-elected. The focus of the sessions was on moving past the campaign mentality and into governance.

The sessions featured a star-studded cast of well-qualified and well—known speakers. On Wednesday, the immediate Past President of UBCM, Laurey-Anne Roodenburg welcomed the delegates to the series, followed by the UBCM Executive Director, Gary MacIsaac who gave advice on settling into council. Discussions on development of Codes of Conduct was informative and spirited. Frank Leonard, Past chair of the MFA, UBCM and other illustrious public offices led animated presentation on the roles and responsibilities of members of Council.

On Thursday, the focus was on Finance, specifically financial and asset management, decision-making, land use planning and climate action.
