




Presentation to City of West Kelowna



Who we are

- Established in 1991, encompassing properties originally mapped out under the Veterans' Land Act to provide farming opportunities for servicemen following the Second World War, as well as adjoining neighbourhoods of Sunnyside and Mission Hill.
- Our mission is to enhance, engage and represent our diverse neighbourhood, where we live, work and play, by facilitating partnerships, programs and services with all levels of government and other stakeholders.





What we've done

- Worked with developer to ensure appropriate design and size of Lakeview Village commercial/residential project.
- Lobbied the City of West Kelowna to provide a sizeable amount of green space to replace the loss of a school playing field.
- Monitored efforts to replace the aging fire hall on Olalla Road.
- Supported projects and initiatives of the Friends of Kalamoir Regional Park.
- Surveyed members on what they felt were key issues facing our area.
- Submitted comments on the Community Visioning and Growth Concept phases of the city's Official Community Plan update.




What now?


- Parks continue to top our list of priorities as infill housing continues. Have prepared a detailed submission to the Parks Master Plan update process.
- Trails and road safety also high on our list. Sidewalk coverage is very poor. More pedestrian/bike paths are urgently required, especially along high-traffic roads (Boucherie, Anders, Thacker).
- Will continue to monitor residential and commercial development in our area to ensure that the OCP lives up to its stated intentions.
- Concerned about the increasingly high cost of liability insurance for directors of non-profit organizations.
