


Legal Services Q4 - 2023

Bylaw Services



- In Q4, Bylaw opened 352 new investigations, of those, 42 remain active.
- Staffing: 3 Bylaw Officers, 1 CSO, on shift Mon-Fri.
- 66 Tickets, and 2 Repeat Nuisance Fees were issued in Q4.
- STA Properties: Bylaw received 4 files from B.L. Dept., and 2 complaints from public; 3 remain active.
- Assisted WildSafeBC: 78 letters drafted/mailed out.
- 2023 YTD: 2,236 Bylaw investigations; 56 active.
- 2023 YTD: 398 Tickets, 4 Court Fines, 8 Repeat Nuisance.
- 2023 YTD: 7 contracted cleanups (recoverable cost)





- Q4 Number of unhoused individuals: 18-20
- CSO continues to patrol the community and parks daily, ensuring large encampments do not accumulate.
- In Q4, CSO reduced data entry to include reports with public interaction only for pro-active community patrols.

2023 YTD: 2,709 reports filed.
