





OCP Public Hearing






- Concerns with the Province of B.C.'s Bill 26 approval of development applications without a public hearing.
- Support of section 2.2, the Land Use Designations Summary, detailing the maximum building heights of 4-storys for low-rise developments and 6-storeys for mid-rise developments but do not support the maximum of 19 stories for high-rise <u>developments.</u>
- Concern the OCP has been negatively influenced by the <u>Urban Development Institute</u>; self-proclaimed the voice of Okanagan development.




