



Types of Transit Service

Kelowna Regional Transit System (KRTS)

Primary Network:	primarily designed to serve and connect Transit Core Areas within the Central Okanagan Region
Rapid Transit Network (RTN)	move high volumes of passengers between major regional destinations along key transportation corridors utilizing exclusive or semi-exclusive right-of-way with limited stop service
Frequent Transit Network (FTN)	provides key corridors with convenient, reliable and frequent service to carry large share of total ridership justifying investment in transit stop amenities and corridor branding
Secondary Network:	provide service within local areas
Local Transit Network (LTN)	connect neighbourhoods within Transit Coverage Areas to local destinations AND the RTN/FTN
Targeted Services	collection of transit services which include handyDART, regional, express and rural transit services most often provided by the custom transit system
