



## Types of Transit Service

### Kelowna Regional Transit System (KRTS)

#### Primary Network:

primarily designed to serve and connect Transit Core Areas within the Central Okanagan Region

#### Rapid Transit Network (RTN)

move high volumes of passengers between major regional destinations along key transportation corridors utilizing exclusive or semi-exclusive right-of-way with limited stop service

#### Frequent Transit Network (FTN)

provides key corridors with convenient, reliable and frequent service to carry large share of total ridership justifying investment in transit stop amenities and corridor branding

#### Secondary Network:

provide service within local areas

#### Local Transit Network (LTN)

connect neighbourhoods within Transit Coverage Areas to local destinations AND the RTN/FTN

#### Targeted Services

collection of transit services which include handyDART, regional, express and rural transit services most often provided by the custom transit system
