Highlights of the Regional Board Meeting – April 29, 2019

Music Festival Temporary Use Permit

The Regional Board has given conditional approval for a Temporary Use Permit to allow the Gonzo Music Festival at Sunset Ranch Golf Course. This is the second year for the event which is expected to attract 1,000 people. It will be held on Friday, June 14th from 3:30 – 10:30 pm. Among the conditions for Board approval: the applicant is required to obtain necessary permits from the Liquor and Cannabis Licensing Branch, RCMP and Interior Health and that all parking be contained on site.

FrontCounter BC Referral Applications

The Regional Board has given conditional support for two applications made to FrontCounter BC from the Recreation Sites and Trails Branch of the Ministry of Forests.

The first application proposes to maintain and legally designate Crown land as a recreation site or trail for existing facilities at the Dog House Cabin Recreation Site and Priest Creek Cabin Recreation Site in the vicinity of Myra-Bellevue Provincial Park, east of Kelowna on the McCulloch Snowmobile Trails.

The second application proposes to formally designate an approximately 4.2-hectare recreation site and amenities at the Greystokes Staging Area that have been developed in partnership with the Kelowna Snowmobile Club.

Each application would bring current site uses into compliance with Provincial regulations.

Infrastructure Planning Grant

The Regional Board has received a letter from the Minister of Municipal Affairs and Housing. In it, Selina Robinson advises that her ministry is providing a \$10,000 infrastructure planning grant which will be used in developing the first phase of the Okanagan Lakes Protection Strategy.

Planning Applications Extended

The Regional Board has approved the following application extension for one year:

- 1) Remove any standing water that mosquitoes can breed in.


Stop False Alarms
