Background

- RDCO Bylaw 1315


- Regulates all wastewater entering the Westside Regional Wastewater Treatment Plant (WRWTP)

- Issue:

- High strength wastewater released from businesses
- Bylaw 1315 requires pre-treatment
- Lack of pre-treatment -> Downstream impacts


PLANT LOADING CAPACITY



Background – Plant Performance

- **WRWTP - Performance Challenges**
 - Associated with nutrient removal
 - Likely causes:
 - Chemicals
 - Concentrated wastes from business & industry
 - Process limitations

Background - Regulatory exceedances (2018-2025)



Background – Actions Taken

- **Source Control:**

- Site inspections, sampling, and compliance orders
- Education focused efforts – fines only when necessary

- **Plant Performance:**

- Investigated wastewater
- Engaged WRWTP design engineer
- Engaged consultants for additional support
- Adjusting operating procedures and process controls
- Piloting temporary measures

Next Steps – Bylaw Enforcement

- RDCO has already:
 - Led with engagement and warnings
 - Provided ample time for compliance
 - Established a cross-jurisdiction staff working group
- Next steps:
 - Adjust RDCO bylaw to enable maximum financial penalties
 - “Ensure penalties are high enough so this doesn’t become part of normal business”
 - Continue to collaborate with Municipal and First Nation partners

Bylaw Penalties

- Apply financial penalties to non-compliant users
 - \$50,000 long form
 - \$3,000 tickets, per day, per offence

All fines and penalties collected will go into Westside Wastewater Reserves to offset operating and capital expenses

What if we can't fix it?

- Regulatory obligations must be met on an ongoing basis
- 2025 will be an important year:
 - If we resolve the issues, maintain ~2032 upgrade date for WWTP.
 - Additional time to build reserves & prepare for grants
 - If issues persist, fast track upgrades to ~2027/2028 (\$30M)
 - Reserve will not be sufficient, grants may not be available
