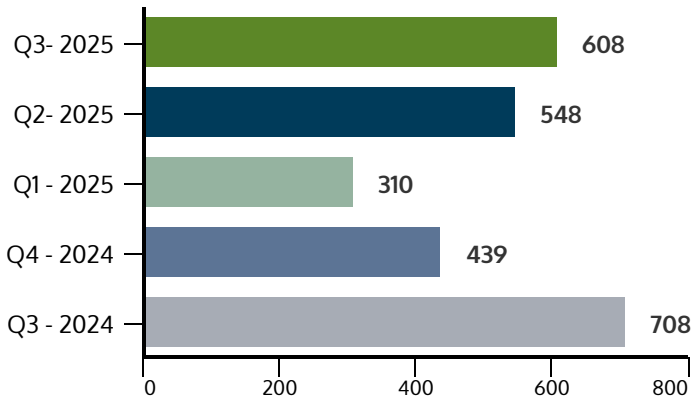


Bylaw Services Q3 - 2025

Bylaw - Calls for Service



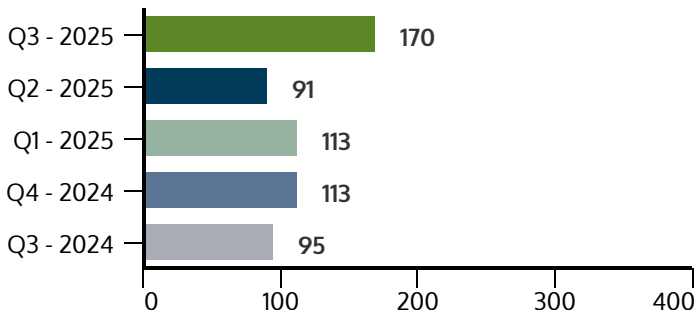
- In Q3, Bylaw opened 608 new investigations. 66 files remain active, plus 14 outstanding files from Q1 & Q2.
- Bylaw assisted in 9 investigations in Q3 and delivered 26 notices for other CWK departments.
- 28 letters were sent by Bylaw on behalf of WildsafeBC after bin tagging patrols. Bear awareness signs were proactively installed in 3 neighbourhoods due to wildlife activity reported to Bylaw.

Community Support Officer (CSO) - Calls for Service



- Patrols, clean ups, and investigations, for safety reasons, often require the attendance of two Officers, drawing General Duty to CSO's and vice versa.
- Using Crime Prevention Through Environmental Design Principles (CPTED), Bylaw Services partnered with the Parks Dept. to clear vegetation to enhance safety and security at areas of congregation within the community.
