### Highlights of the Regional Board Meeting - March 12, 2020

#### **Development Cost Charges Bylaw**

The Regional Board has given three readings to a bylaw updating Development Cost Charges for new résidential and commercial development in West Kelowna, Peachland and Westbank First Nation lands. Funds raised through the bylaw will be used to build reserves and assist with an expected \$30million in infrastructure upgrades over the next 20 years for the RDCO's Westside Regional Wastewater Treatment Plant and sewage collection system. The facility treats wastewater from the City of West Kelowna, District of Peachland and Westbank First Nation reserves #9 and #10. The bylaw requires approval from the Provincial Inspector Municipalities before being adopted by the Regional Board.

#### 9-1-1 Call Answer Levy Supported

The Regional Board has adopted a resolution supporting and advocating for a province-wide 9-1-1 call answer levy on cell phones. The fee would be used to provide a consistent application of 9-1-1 service standards and align with the federal network of public safety answering points across the country. The Board Chair will also send a letter to the BC minister of Public Safety and Solicitor General advising its support for the new fee on cell phones. Currently a 9-1-1 fee is only levied on landlines.

#### **North Okanagan Regional Growth Strategy**

The Regional Board has accepted proposed amendments updating the Regional District of North Okanagan Regional Growth Strategy (RGS) Bylaw. The *Local Government Act* requires that affected local governments be consulted and accept Regional Growth Strategy bylaws. The North Okanagan has been updating its RGS since 2015.
