RE: Fees and Charges Bylaw No. 0028.65, 2020 - Recreation and Culture

RECOMMENDED MOTION:

THAT the "City of West Kelowna Fees and Charges Amendment Bylaw No. 0028.65, 2020" be adopted.

BACKGROUND:

Bylaw No. 0028.65 was given 3 readings on February 25, 2020. The Bylaw is before Council for consideration of adoption.

West Kelowna's recreation fees are the lowest amongst neighbouring communities of Penticton, Kelowna, Vernon and Kamloops. The proposed annual rate increase of 3% over the next three years ensures continued reasonable rates, is consistent with increases provided in neighbouring communities and the cost of living.

The proposed changes to the Fees and Charges Bylaw allows the City of West Kelowna to deliver a more efficient recreation service that is inclusive of all members of the community. Recommended changes to the General Admission fee structure provides a more accessible recreation service to all age groups while establishing a clear and consistent process for determining and evaluating recreation fees in the future.
