2515 Bartley Road Temporary Shelter

The proposed plan:

- Modular shelter on the existing empty lot at 2515 Bartley Road
- 38 individual rooms
- Open in Fall of 2021
- Staffed 24 hours a day, seven days a week
- Operating for up to 3 years based on this current TUP application.





Modular Shelter Benefits

- Designated kitchen, hygiene facilities, common areas and individual sleeping areas
- Modular shelter provides a safe space for shelter guests and staff given the current COVID-19 pandemic.
- Individual rooms allow shelter guests to gain independence to help them to their next housing stage
- Quick construction; minimizing impact on community, neighbours and shelter quests
