

Highlights of the Regional Board meeting – July 8, 2021

Regional Park management plan

The Regional Board has approved a new management plan for the 92-hectare Mission Creek Regional Park. The plan was created with public and stakeholder involvement and provides a long-term vision to help guide future park development and management opportunities. The plan estimates about \$3-million in capital park development and asset renewal costs (subject to budget approvals) over the next 20 years and includes:

- Management zones and carrying capacities
- A conceptual park development plan
- Park management goals and objectives
- A 20-year phased implementation plan

Updated playground maintenance policy

The Regional Board approved an updated policy to guide maintenance and management of playgrounds in RDCO parks. The policy complies with the most recent 2020 Canadian Standards Association guidelines for the maintenance of existing playgrounds and the installation of new playground equipment within parks operated by the Regional District.

Air Quality Radon Challenge program

The Regional Board approves continuing the collaboration of the Air Quality program and stakeholders and supporting proposed next steps to help reduce radon gas exposure in the Central Okanagan. Last fall, the program coordinated the distribution of approximately 1,400 free radon gas test kits to home owners across the region through the initiative involving Take Action on Radon, BC Lung Association, Interior Health and all local governments. Participants receive their radon gas test results and information on possible steps to take in order to reduce radon gas levels in their home. It's anticipated additional free test kits will be made available this fall supporting efforts to raise awareness about the naturally occurring radon gas, which is the second leading cause of lung cancer in Canadians.
