



Q4 ZONE COMPARISONS





Due to regional wide staffing challenges, CSU members have been assisting the General Duty watches in order to support them in their daily responsibilities.




POLICE/COMMUNITY RELATIONS

- Consulted with another policing agency regarding the implementation of a program that assists gang members of getting out of the lifestyle




VIOLENCE IN RELATIONSHIPS
