GOAT'S PEAK DEVELOPMENT - TEMPORARY SIGNAGE PROPOSAL




For the purpose of this proposal, we've adopted the term "Community" to denote the future neighbourhood name. It is our intention to release the brand identity for this community in conjunction with the temporary development signage launch.

DEVELOPMENT SIGNAGE

During the initial phases of development, a key to building awareness for Community will reside in being able to tell the brand story and foster engagement with both existing neighbourhood groups and targeted in-market-buyers alike.

This signage plan is a proposed strategy for capturing and redirecting northbound and southbound traffic from Highway 97 onto Gellatly Road. Throughout various stages of development, the key entrance to Community will be a high traffic location for construction vehicles and machinery, but the east facing slopes of Goats Peak present a unique opportunity to convey the vision for this neighbourhood in a way that befits the land and outdoor lifestyle that Community promises.

When completed, the east facing slopes of Goats Peak will include a primary information hub and parking space, with an orientation trail that connects visitors with the land.




- Re-Directional Sign


EXISTING TRAIL TO GOATS PEAK REGIONAL PARK








