2019 Citizens' Survey

#### **RECOMMENDED MOTION:**

**THAT** Council direct staff to conduct an online 2019 Citizens' Survey to run from June 10 to 28, 2019, and concurrently distribute to 1,000 randomly selected homes a direct-mail survey, with processing and analysis completed internally and the results of both surveys provided to Council.

#### BACKGROUND:

The 2018 Citizens' Survey was the 11th direct mail, statistically-accurate survey conducted by the City. The survey was experiencing a decline in responses over the past three years and results did not represent an accurate demographic sampling of the populace, with a larger than proportional number of respondents aged over 55. West Kelowna Council requested the City's Communications Department investigate offering an online survey in the interest of attracting more respondents from younger age groups.

A voluntary online survey will not be considered statistically accurate as the City cannot control with certainty who will fill out a survey or how many times a survey can be taken by an individual. However, statistical significance of online survey results corresponds with the number of surveys completed; if more surveys are completed, results are more statistically significant. The City can also carefully review online results to determine if multiple, identical surveys are submitted by the same IP address (numerical label assigned to a device connected to a computer network).

Communications recommends both versions of the survey be conducted. The statistically accurate, mailed survey results can then be compared with the online survey results to help establish confidence in online surveys of this nature.

The significant benefit of an online survey is the cost which, at approximately \$450 for the purchase of an online service, is significantly lower than the cost to print and mail the surveys at approximately \$3,200. The direct-mail survey is created in-house and data entry is completed by City staff; this is not calculated in the cost. Similar statistically-accurate surveys, including telephone polls, online surveys with access codes and direct-mailed surveys can cost \$15,000 to \$30,000 when conducted by a consultant.

As there are some members of the community without access to the internet, the City will provide the option to obtain a paper copy of the survey at City Hall which can be manually completed and handed in.

Both the surveys will be anonymous with only high-level demographic information collected, ensuring the City maintains compliance with Canadian and provincial privacy laws.

Pending Council's approval, Communications will mail out 1,000 surveys in late May to randomly selected West Kelowna property owners from each of the City's neighbourhoods. Participants are provided a stamped, addressed envelope to return their completed surveys to the City by June 28, 2019. Pending Council's approval, Communications will also prepare an online survey to run from June 10 to June 28, 2019.

Communications will encourage West Kelowna residents to take the survey through promotion via the media, newspaper advertising, website e-notification, and social media posts.

Results will be tabulated and provided to Council in summer 2019.

Attached for Council's review and comments is the draft 2019 Citizens' Survey questionnaire.

#### **FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS:**

- Printing and mail out of 1,000 surveys, with addressed, stamped envelopes included costs approximately \$3,200
- Online survey service subscription \$450/year

#### **ALTERNATE RECOMMENDATION:**

THAT Council direct staff to conduct an online survey only from June 10 to 28, 2019 with results provided to Council.


