Highlights of the Regional Board Meeting - August 26, 2019

Ellison Community Centre Agreement

The Regional Board has approved a new Operating and Recreational Programming Delivery Agreement with the Ellison Parks and Recreation Society for the Ellison Heritage School Community Hall. The new agreement runs to the end of 2022 and the Society will continue scheduling of all activities and use of the hall. The Society is responsible for all operations and maintenance of the facility while the Regional District is responsible for major capital improvements to the hall.

Gas Tax Funding Received

The Regional Board has received a letter from the Union of BC Municipalities (UBCM) which administers funding to local government from the Canada-BC Community Works Fund. The RDCO will receive just over \$1,080,617 in gas tax funding to be allocated to the Central Okanagan East and Central Okanagan West electoral areas for eligible projects. The funding includes a one-time payment identified in the Federal budget of \$705,850.

Secondary Suite Application

The Regional Board has adopted a Joe Rich Rural Land Use Bylaw amendment to allow a secondary suite at 7520 Goudie Road in the Joe Rich area. The applicant plans to add a secondary suite in the basement of the existing dwelling on the property located in the Central Okanagan East Electoral Area.

Climate Action Recognition

The Regional Board has been advised by the Union of BC Municipalities Green Communities Committee that the regional district has received Level 2 recognition for Measuring Greenhouse Gas Emissions. The RDCO is a signatory to the provincial Climate Action Charter and recently completed its annual community energy and emissions inventory.
